महर्षि दयानंद सरस्वती जी की 200वीं जयंती

पी.जी.डी.ए.वी. महाविद्यालय महर्षि दयानंद सरस्वती जी के आदर्शों एवं शिक्षाओं को पूर्णतया आत्मसात करने वाला संस्थान है। यह संस्थान ज्ञान, अनुसंधान और भारतीय संस्कृति का एक केन्द्र है। इसका ध्येय विद्यार्थियों को बौद्धिक रूप से सक्षम, नैतिक रूप से जागृत एवं समाज व राष्ट्र निर्माण के प्रति समर्पित बनाना है। हम सभी के लिए अत्यंत गौरव का विषय है कि यह वर्ष महर्षि दयानंद सरस्वती जी के 200वीं जयंती का वर्ष है। महर्षि दयानंद जी आधुनिक भारत के चिंतक एवं 'आर्य समाज'(1875ई.) के संस्थापक थे। उनके द्वारा रचित 'सत्यार्थ प्रकाश' आर्य समाज का मूल ग्रन्थ है। महर्षि दयानंद सरस्वती जी की 200वीं जयंती कई मायनों में ऐतिहासिक एवं महत्वपूर्ण है। जब पूरी दुनिया अनेक विवादों, संघर्षों एवं हिंसा से घिरी हुई है; ऐसे समय में महर्षि दयानंद जी का आदर्श वाक्य 'कृण्वन्तो विश्वमार्यम्' की प्रासंगिकता स्वतः बढ़ जाती है, जिसका अर्थ है हम पूरे विश्व को श्रेष्ठ बनाएं व पूरे विश्व में श्रेष्ठ विचारों एवं मानवीय आदर्शों का संचार करें। G-20 का आदर्श वाक्य 'एक धरती, एक परिवार, एक भविष्य' भी महर्षि जी की ही शिक्षाओं की पुष्टि करता है।

महर्षि दयानंद जी ने हमें जीवन जीने का मंत्र दिया। वर्ष 1876 में 'भारत, भारतीयों के लिये' के रूप में स्वराज का आह्वान करने वाले वे पहले व्यक्ति थे। उनके एक अखंड भारत के दृष्टिकोण में वर्गहीन और जातिविहीन समाज तथा विदेशी शासन से मुक्त भारत शामिल था, जिसमें 'आर्य धर्म' सभी का सामान्य धर्म हो। उन्होंने वेदों से प्रेरणा ली और उन्हें हिंदू धर्म को सच्चा मूल बीज' माना। उन्होंने महिलाओं के खिलाफ भेदभाव का खंडन किया और महिला शिक्षा अभियान भी शुरू किया। महर्षि दयानंद जी ने शिक्षा प्रणाली में पूरी तरह से बदलाव की शुरुआत की। उनके दृष्टिकोण को साकार करने के लिये ही वर्ष 1886 में डी.ए.वी. (दयानंद एंग्लो वैदिक) स्कूल अस्तित्व में आया।

भारत सरकार ने महर्षि दयानंद सरस्वती जी के 200वीं जयंती के महोत्सव को दो वर्षों तक मनाने का निर्णय लिया है। इसकी जिम्मेदारी हमारे देश के माननीय यशस्वी प्रधानमंत्री श्री नरेन्द्र मोदी जी ने 'आर्य समाज' को सौंपते हुए कहा कि 'मुझे विश्वास है, आर्य समाज राष्ट्र और समाज के प्रति इन कर्तव्य यज्ञों को आयोजित करता रहेगा, यज्ञ का प्रकाश मानवता के लिए प्रसारित करता रहेगा।' महर्षि दयानंद जी के 200वीं जयंती के सम्मान में माननीय उपराष्ट्रपति श्री जगदीप धनखड़ जी ने स्मारक डाक टिकट जारी किया। महर्षि दयानंद सरस्वती जी का द्विशताब्दी वर्ष पी.जी.डी.ए.वी. महाविद्यालय द्वारा 28 मार्च, 2023 को अत्यन्त उत्कृष्ट और भव्य तरीके से मनाया गया। यह बताते हुए हम अत्यंत सम्मानित महसूस कर रहे हैं कि इस विशिष्ट और पावन अवसर पर महाविद्यालय में महर्षि दयानंद सरस्वती जी की प्रस्तर छवि रूप और नवनिर्मित खेल परिसर का अनावरण किया गया। पी.जी.डी.ए.वी. एलुमनाई एसोसिएशन द्वारा भी 12 फरवरी, 2023 को महर्षि दयानंद सरस्वती का द्विशताब्दी वर्ष अत्यंत भव्य तरीके से मनाया गया।

पी.जी.डी.ए.वी. महाविद्यालय की नई शक्ति और सूरत देखकर अत्यंत खुशी हो रही है। महाविद्यालय को देखकर हृदय के भाव सहज ही प्रस्फुटित हो रहे हैं-

“होगी ये ईमारत ईट-पत्थरों की औरों के लिए,
मैंने तो इसके गलीचों से खुदा का नूर टपकते देखा है।”

इसके लिए मैं महाविद्यालय की प्राचार्य प्रो. कृष्णा शर्मा जी को हृदय की गहराइयों से बधाई देता हूँ। हम सभी के लिए अत्यंत हर्ष और सम्मान का विषय है कि यह वर्ष स्वामी दयानंद सरस्वती जी के जन्म का द्विशताब्दी वर्ष है। इस द्विशताब्दी वर्ष के उत्सव को मनाने की जिम्मेदारी भारत सरकार ने हमारे साथ मिलकर अपने हाथों में ली है। हमें पूरा विश्वास है कि आर्य समाज और भारत सरकार के सहयोग से स्वामी दयानंद जी का स्थान पूरे विश्वपटल पर वहाँ पहुंचेगा, जहाँ उन्हें अब तक होना चाहिए था।

वर्तमान में नैतिक शिक्षा सभी मनुष्यों के लिए अत्यंत आवश्यक है, क्योंकि व्यक्तित्व और राष्ट्र निर्माण में इसकी अपरिहार्य भूमिका है। आज विज्ञान ने इतनी तरक्की कर ली है कि वह किसी भी तरह की मशीन बनाने में सक्षम है, परंतु क्या वह ऐसी मशीन बनाने में सक्षम है, जिससे गलत राह पर चलता हुआ मनुष्य बटन दबाते ही सही राह पर चलने लगे? नहीं है सक्षम। क्योंकि इस कार्य के लिए ‘मनुष्यता’ आवश्यक है। इसके लिए विद्या पर धर्म का अंकुश भी आवश्यक है, नहीं तो विद्या अविद्या भी हो सकती है। परंतु यह ध्यान रहे यहाँ धर्म का अर्थ कर्तव्य है। जैसे सूर्य का धर्म है सुबह उगना और शाम को अस्त होना। अतः यह भी आवश्यक है कि डी.ए.वी. का हर शिक्षक एक धर्म शिक्षक हो। डी.ए.वी. की स्थापना ही स्वामी दयानंद जी के विचारों को आगे बढ़ाने के लिए हुई है। वर्तमान में डी.ए.वी. में 34 लाख विद्यार्थी अध्ययनरत और 1 लाख कर्मचारी कार्यरत हैं।

आज भारत में दो चीजों की बहुत कमी है, पहला देशभक्ति और दूसरा प्रभुभक्ति। ये दोनों ही मनुष्य के पतन के मुख्य कारक हैं। अथर्ववेद में देशभक्ति का पहला गुण ‘सत्य’ है। मुण्डक उपनिषद् में प्रभुभक्ति का पहला गुण भी ‘सत्य’ ही है। यहाँ ‘सत्य’ का तात्पर्य सिर्फ ‘सच बोलना’ बहुत सीमित है। ‘सत्य’ है- सत्य आहार, सत्य विचार, सत्य आचार, सत्य व्यवहार और सत्य आधार। सत्य आधार का अर्थ है, वह खाओ जो आपके लिए हितैषी और मर्यादा में हो। नेक नियत और नेक कमाई का खाओ। सत्य विचार से तात्पर्य है, विचार को हमेशा सत्य रखें और नकारात्मक विचार को तुरंत दूर करें। गंदे विचारों से मनुष्य का सर्वस्व नाश होता है। सत्य आचार का व्यापक अर्थ है, जैसा व्यवहार आप दूसरे के साथ करेंगे, वैसा ही व्यवहार समाज से आपको भी मिलेगा। यदि आपके पास खाना है और किसी भूखे का पेट नहीं भरते हैं, तो आपने अपना चरित्र खो दिया है। सत्य व्यवहार का तात्पर्य है- सत्यम् शिवम् सुंदरम्। अर्थात् सत्य व्यवहार सिर्फ सच बोलना नहीं है। यदि आपके झूठ से किसी का कल्याण हो रहा है, तो वह भी सत्य व्यवहार है। सत्य आधार अर्थ है, जो कभी न खत्म हो। जो कभी साथ न छोड़े। जब आपके पास कुछ भी न हो, तब भी आधार आपके साथ रहे। जैसे जल का आधार समुद्र है।

डी.ए.वी. के शिक्षकों का कार्य इसी आधार की तरह होना चाहिए।

मुझे आप सभी के समक्ष शैक्षणिक सत्र 2022-23 की हमारे महाविद्यालय के शैक्षणिक और गैर-शैक्षणिक क्रियाकलापों व नई गतिविधियों की संक्षिप्त रूपरेखा प्रस्तुत करते हुए अपार हर्ष हो रहा है। सत्र की शुरुआत राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति, 2020 के सफल क्रियान्वयन के साथ हुई थी। कट ऑफ आधारित प्रवेश प्रक्रिया की जगह सीयूईटी पर आधारित नई प्रवेश प्रक्रिया के माध्यम से महाविद्यालय ने दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा तैयार किए गए नए पाठ्यक्रम को अपनाया है। हमने राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति को पूरी तरह अपनाते हुए पाठ्यक्रम के नए प्रारूप और शिक्षण के नए तौर-तरीकों को अपनाया है।

बेहतर शैक्षणिक परिवेश निर्मित करने के लिए महाविद्यालय ने स्थायी तौर पर नए प्राध्यापकों की नियुक्तियों के आतिरिक्त शैक्षणिक एवं गैर-शैक्षणिक लगभग सभी पदोन्नति की प्रक्रिया को सफलतापूर्वक पूरा किया है। शैक्षणिक आधारभूत संरचना किसी भी शैक्षणिक संस्था का अभिन्न अंग होता है। पिछले एक वर्ष में महाविद्यालय की आधारभूत संरचना में अभूतपूर्व परिवर्तन आया है, जिसे सहज रूप से चिह्नित किया जा सकता है। हमने पिछले शैक्षणिक वर्ष में नई ई-लाइब्रेरी, कंप्यूटर लैब, सम्मेलन कक्ष और स्वामी दयानंद सरस्वती जी को समर्पित बेहतर खेल परिसर आदि का निर्माण किया है। हाल ही में पद्म श्री डॉ. पूनम सूरी (अध्यक्ष डी.ए.वी. कॉलेज प्रबंध समिति) ने भी इसे चिह्नित किया है और इसकी प्रशंसा भी की है। महान संत और 'आर्य समाज' के संस्थापक स्वामी दयानंद सरस्वती जी 19वीं शताब्दी के अग्रणी सामाजिक सुधार आंदोलन की समृद्ध विरासत के अग्रदूत थे। 'आर्य समाज' के मूल में अध्यात्म, वैज्ञानिक शिक्षा, तर्कसंगतता, सार्वभौमिक शिक्षा और महिला शिक्षा प्रमुख है।

परीक्षा परिणाम का विश्लेषण यह दर्शाता है कि महाविद्यालय के कई विभागों जैसे- अर्थशास्त्र, राजनीति विज्ञान, सांख्यिकी आदि में स्नातक के विद्यार्थियों का उत्तीर्ण प्रतिशत शत-प्रतिशत तक पहुंच गया है। विश्वविद्यालय के वर्तमान वार्षिकोत्सव में स्नातकोत्तर पाठ्यक्रम के विद्यार्थियों ने भी अपनी प्रतिभा दर्शायी है। 10 में से 09 सीजीपीए प्राप्त करना हमारे विद्यार्थियों और साथ ही साथ हमारे प्राध्यापकों के समर्पण और कठिन परिश्रम को दर्शाता है। हमारा महाविद्यालय ट्युमेन विश्वविद्यालय, रूस और प. रविशंकर शुक्ल विश्वविद्यालय, रायपुर, छत्तीसगढ़ के साथ समझौता ज्ञापनों पर हस्ताक्षर करके शैक्षणिक रूप से अपना विस्तार कर रहा है।

Chief guest Shri Indresh Kumar Ji, guest of honour Dr Sudhanshu Trivedi Ji, Prof Deepak Srivastav Ji, Shri Shiv Raman Gaur Ji, chair of today's ceremony Shri Ajay Suri Ji, my colleagues, my dear students and friends, I welcome you all to the annual day and the prize distribution ceremony of our college.

I warmly welcome our chief guest Shri Indresh Kumar Ji, with a sense of humility. Mananiya Shri Indresh Kumar Ji is the nationalist thinker and a senior member of the National Executive, Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS). He is also the patron and the key person of the Muslim Rashtriya Manch (MRM), an organization of the RSS. Indresh Kumar Ji was born on 18th February 1949 in Samana, Punjab, to puja Shrimati Padmavati and Shri Chaman Lal Ji. He completed his Mechanical Engineering from Punjab Engineering College, Chandigarh, with a Gold Medal. Afterwards, Indresh ji moved to Delhi and started his service to our nation as a preacher of the RSS in 1970. Since then, he has been working in the service of the Nation. In 1975, during emergency in India, Indresh Ji played an active role in the underground movement and later in 1979 he worked as a coordinator in Dilli Badh Pidit Sahayata Samiti.

He played a key role in nation building efforts of RSS, such as, Jammu Kashmir Sahayata Samiti during 1990s, Himalaya Parivar Aandolan in 2001, Sindhu Utsav for Laddakh Tourism, Nepali Sanskriti Parishad in 2006, Bangladesh Maitri Parishad, Jammu Kashmir ki Shaurya Gaatha, Kashmir Samasya Avam Samadhan and for the facilities of Amarnath Yatris. In order to connect to the Muslims to Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS), Indresh Ji, formed the Muslim Rashtriya Manch (MRM) on 24th December 2002. Under the banner of one of his organisations, Forum for Integrated National Security (FINS) he started a yatra named 'Salute to the Border' in which Lakhs of young men and women travelled to the border areas of the country. Currently he is the Chief Patron of Bharat Tibet Sahyog Manch. Shri Indresh Kumar ji is also mentor of Forum for Awareness of National Security (FANS) which was formed on 25th December, 2014 with branches in many states to create awareness about national security among the masses. Thank you, sir, for accepting our invitation.

I welcome our guest of honour Dr Sudhanshu Trivedi Ji. Sudhanshu Ji is an Indian politician. A leader of Bharatiya Janata Party and a Member of Parliament from Upper House, Rajya Sabha. Dr. Trivedi is serving as the National Spokesperson of Bharatiya Janata Party. Having done PhD in Mechanical Engineering he served as a faculty in Mechanical Engineering department in a couple of Indian Universities. He also worked as Information Advisor to the former UP Chief Minister and also Political Advisor to former BJP National President Rajnath Singh (the current Defence Minister of India). He is an ardent speaker on the issues of India's National policy, Polity, Society and Indic Civilization values. Thank you, sir, for your time.

I welcome our guest of honour Prof. Deepak Srivastav. Prof. Srivastav is currently the Vice-Chairman of UGC. Prof Srivastava completed his graduation in 1979 and Post-graduation with Gold Medal in Commerce in 1981 from University of Allahabad. He was awarded Doctorate in Commerce in 1989. Prof. Srivastava joined Dayalbagh Educational Institute (DEI), Agra in 1984 and after 16 years of significant contribution in DEI he joined Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS), Mumbai in January 2001. Dr. Srivastava has supervised several Doctoral and



Master's dissertations at TISS, Mumbai. Prior to joining UGC as Vice Chairman, Dr. Srivastava was Professor, School of Management and Labour Studies at Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Mumbai Campus. I thank you sir for gracing the occasion.

I welcome our guest of honour Shri Shiv Raman Gaur. Shri Gaur Ji is currently treasurer of the PGDAV Governing Body. He is a retired IAS officer and heads the higher education of DAV College Managing Committee. As I stand here to present the Annual Report of our college for the academic year 2022-23, I am filled with a sense of great pride and achievement. This Annual Report becomes special for me since our college has witnessed a phenomenal growth in different parameters of academic and extra academic fields. We have successfully completed promotions of 130 faculty members and 11 non-teaching staff in addition to the appointment of 40 permanent faculty members in different departments. Soon we will complete the recruitment process in other departments also. Our faculty members are actively involved in their research work in addition to the teaching and administrative assignment in the college. The University exam results of our undergraduate students are satisfactory since the pass percentage of many departments have reached hundred per cent. The results of our post-graduate students have also seen a new high, with students receiving 9.5 CGPA out of ten. One of our students was awarded Gold Medal by the University of Delhi.

Focus on infrastructural development was the key highlight of this academic year. A new user-interactive, accessible and bilingual-Hindi & English website has been designed and launched. New administrative block was built to make student dealings more interactive and hassle free. Staff room was fully renovated to make academic environment more effective. A new Conference room was built in the library to facilitate research activities in the college. We built a new environment science lab and a computer lab to cater to the needs of students in changing times. The access of catalogue and resources in the library by the students is more advanced with new OPAC and e-library system. To commemorate the second birth centenary of Swami Dayanand Saraswati, Padamshree Dr. Punam Suri Ji, President DAV College Managing Committee has unveiled the portrait of Swami Dayanand Saraswati Ji in principal's office gallery. He has also inaugurated the new sports complex, well equipped with four flood lights to facilitate day night matches and a synthetic running track on the periphery of the ground.

Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education (MGNCRE), under the Ministry of Education, Government of India, has recognized the efforts of the college in sustainability, and

for this we were issued a certificate of Sustainable campus. The college has also been declared as a zero-waste management by the Deputy Commissioner, Central Zone Municipal Corporation of Delhi for its efforts of wet and dry waste segregation. Another remarkable step taken by our college is the conservation of water. Effluent water of R.O. plant is re-used in college washrooms conserving around 1600 litres water per day.

I am presenting this annual report at a time when our nation is celebrating, with responsibility, the presidency of G20 and promoting the Indian values, like Vasudhaiv Kutumbkam. India has shown both its prowess and love for peace to the international community, under the leadership of honourable Prime Minister Narendra Modi Ji. Our college aims to progress in tune with the progress of our nation. The Government of India is celebrating the second birth centenary of Swami Dayanand Saraswati and DAV managing committee is the nodal agency for the same. It is a great moment for us. Our college is also celebrating the two hundred years of birth of Maharshi Daranand Saraswati Ji and we have dedicated many seminars, talks, extra-academic activities and the newly constructed sports complex to him and his values.

In the words of Swami Vivekanand, the advancement of a nation depends upon the spread of education among the masses. With this view in mind, we are striving to impart education, both academic and value based, to the younger generation under the broad framework of National Education Policy 2020, implemented from this academic session. This college was established on the ideals of Maharshi Dayanand Saraswati, who believed that modern scientific education blended with civilizational ethos of India is one of the best teaching-learning method. We follow his ideals and therefore inculcate among students' ethical values and wisdom necessary for a strong character and national spirit. Department and Faculty Achievements

Department of Commerce

The Department of Commerce, organized a short-term certificate course titled 'The Indian Contract Act-1872& Remedies for Breach of Contract', from 16th January to 03rd February, 2023. Over forty students had visited SEBI to understand their functioning. SEBI had also visited to our college to celebrate "World Investor Week 2022". 9. **Late Smt. Raj Mohan Memorial Prize** of Rs. 1500, to the students securing highest marks in B.A. (Hons) Hindi 3rd year.
10. **Late Shri Ugar Sen Mohan Memorial Prize** of Rs. 1250, to the students securing highest marks in B.A. (Hons) English 3rd year.
11. **Students Aid Fund (SAF) (2022-23):** It is one of the recognized funds which is contributed from the college fee of the students by the P.G.D.A.V. College. It is utilized to waive off the fee of the students belonging to the economically weaker section of the society. A total of 141 students received financial assistance under this scheme and the amount of fee waived off by the college was Rs. 6,98,000.
12. **Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Best Student Award** of Rs. 5100, is given in the memory of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar. This prize is awarded to the best student of the year on the basis of academic and extra-curricular activities performance.
13. **P.G.D.A.V. College Student Welfare Fund:** This fund was set up in the year 2021-22. It is raised by the donation given by existing faculties of the College for providing financial assistance and support to those students who have lost their parents during the COVID-19. The given fund is utilized for providing Financial Aid to the needy students

facing problems in paying their college fee. Donation of Rs. 50,000 has been received during the academic session 2022-23.

Scholarship sponsored by NGOs

1. **Help the Blind Fund (2022-23):** It is one of the recognized fund provided by “Help the Blind” an NGO. This grant has been provided to the College for providing financial assistance exclusively to the blind students. Number of Blind Students received financial assistance is 25 and the Grant received per student is Rs. 10,000. Total financial assistance is Rs. 2,50,000.

Scholarship sponsored by the Government of India and various State Governments

- 1.) **National Scholarship Portal (NSP) (2021-22):** National Scholarship Portal (NSP) is a digital platform that carries scholarships offered by the central government, state government and different government agencies like University Grants Commission (UGC). The NSP Portal is taken as a Mission Mode Project under National e-Governance Plan (NeGP). The scholarship is provided to the minorities students who seek financial assistance. The amount of the scholarship differs from state to state as each state has prescribed its own guidelines. A total of 69 students have received financial assistance under this head.
- 2.) **Post Matric Scholarship for SC/ST/OBC students (2021-22):** Welfare Department of SC/ST/OBC, Govt. of NCT of Delhi provides Scholarship Schemes for the students belonging to SC/ST/OBC/Minority category in National capital Territory of Delhi from 1st December 2019. A total of 17 students have received this scholarship.
- 3.) **Prime Minister's Special Scholarship Scheme (PMSSS) (2021-22):** Prime Minister's Special Scholarship Scheme (PMSSS), J&K is an initiative of the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) for Class 12 passed/diploma degree holders in J&K and Ladakh. The scholarship aims to support the youth of J&K to pursue higher education outside the state. It facilitates access to quality education for students so as to equip them with knowledge, skills, experience, and training for higher academic levels/professions. The selected students will receive financial assistance up to INR 3 lakhs and a maintenance allowance of INR 1 lakh per annum. A total of 28 students of our college have received financial help under this scheme.

Career Development Centre

CADEC has been established with the basic idea of giving wings to the dreams of entrepreneurs. CADEC, the career development centre at P.G.D.A.V. college, is a resource hub for students and alumni who are enthusiastic for Entrepreneurship and willing to create their own niche in business world. CADEC is a platform, which provides mentorship, funding assistance, networking opportunities and workshops on various aspects of Entrepreneurship. CADEC also provides assistance with the formulation of business plan, conducting market research and refining product idea. CADEC is a small step towards realizing the bigger objective of Atmanirbhar Bharat.

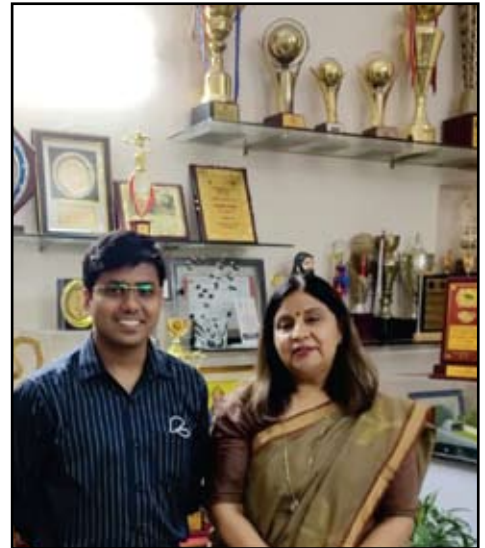
