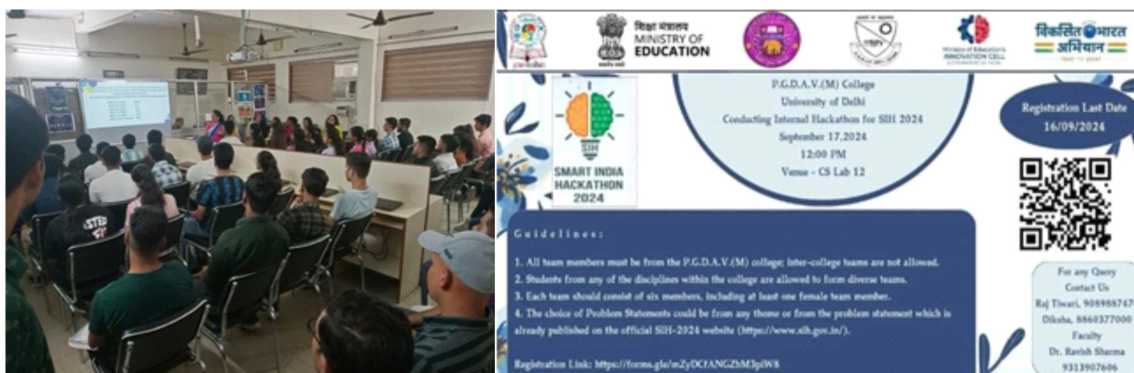

(M) College designated towards shaping up young minds into brilliant programmers and confident individuals by providing them plethora of opportunities by inculcating various activities throughout their college life. Orientation program was conducted on 3rd September 2024 for B.Sc. (H) Computer Science, B.Sc. Mathematical Science, BA (P) Computer Application First year students. They were introduced with the Computer Science teaching faculty. Information regarding the UGCF curriculum framework based on NEP, General Elective papers, Skill enhancement papers, Internal assessment, how to read timetable, future career prospects of the course was delivered. Students were introduced with the student core team of PARIKALAN.



The Internal Smart India Hackathon was conducted on 17th September 2024 in the college premises. The students participated from diverse streams such as Computer Science, Commerce, Political Science, Mathematics and Statistics. The college got an overwhelming response from the students. Each team presented their innovative idea in the format prescribed by SIH 2024. The teams were judged by the three faculty members from Commerce, Mathematics and Environmental Studies departments. Nine teams were shortlisted at the college level.

The workshop on GIT and GITHUB was conducted by B.Sc. Mathematical Science 3rd year student, Raj Tiwari, President- “PARIKALAN”, The Computer Science Society, on 23rd October 2024. The students were introduced with the fundamentals of version control and collaborative software development using Git and GitHub. It was an interactive session designed to help students, understand how to manage code repositories effectively, track changes, and collaborate with others in real-time. 56 students from different courses attended the workshop.



Qiskit Fall Fest, Quantum Computing workshop was conducted by B.Sc. (H) Computer Science student, Mayank Rathore on 14th November 2024. Qiskit Fall Fest is a collection of Quantum Computing events created and planned by university students and volunteer hosts, with support from IBM Quantum. The event brings the world of Quantum Computing to the forefront of technological innovation, making complex concepts accessible to beginners. The event featured Introductory sessions, Hands-on workshops, and interactive demonstrations. Students from institutions like K.R. Mangalam University, YMCA, Dronacharya College of Engineering, Golden Gate University, TIPS, Indraprastha Engineering College and colleges from University of Delhi participated in the workshop in large numbers.

Since October 2024, Dharohar, the History Society of P.G.D.A.V. (M) College, has conducted various impactful events. It began with a football match on 13th November 2024 to encourage teamwork and sportsmanship.

On 21st October 2024, a guest lecture by Prof. Rajinder Dudrah explored Bollywood’s digital media influence. The annual fest on 18th-19th February 2025 featured competitions like quizzes, debates, and treasure hunts, along with expert talks on Indian temples, cultural heritage, and historical foreign travelers’ writings. A debate on 19th February examined whether ancient temples were political hubs or religious centers.



During the fest, on 18th February 2025, Prof. Vijaya Laxmi Singh (DU) spoke on Banaras: Temple, Religion, and Culture in Historical Perspective, while Prof. Kaushal Kumar Sharma (JNU) discussed Kuldevi and Gram Devta in India's Religious Landscape. Anant is the official Mathematics Society of P.G.D.A.V College, University of Delhi. The society is dedicated to promoting the study of mathematics among students, fostering a deeper understanding of mathematical concepts, and encouraging intellectual discussions beyond the classroom. Anant plays a pivotal role in organizing various academic, extracurricular, and outreach activities that connect students with the fascinating world of mathematics, research, and real-world applications. The society annually holds its fest "SPECTRUM" along with the alumni meet "CONFLUENCE".

The society regularly invites experts and renowned mathematicians from various institutions to conduct workshops and seminars on specialized topics in mathematics. The society organizes guest lectures by eminent mathematicians and scholars who share their knowledge and insights on current developments and applications of mathematics in various fields such as physics, computer science, economics, and engineering.

The Mathematics Department organized several events in the current academic session to



enhance student learning. The ORIENTATION held in September introduced new students to faculty, curriculum, and research opportunities. In October, Prof. Swarn Singh delivered an Invited Talk on Differential Equation: Modelling First Approach, followed by an interactive Q&A for freshers. A hands-on Machine Learning Workshop Using R was held in November, equipping students with practical skills. National Mathematics Day, 24th December, honoured Srinivasa Ramanujan with a guest lecture, paper presentations, and competitions. These events fostered academic growth, skill-building, and engagement.

Dr. Geeta Kalucha served as a Jury Member for the Best Undergraduate Presentation Session, and as Chair for the parallel session On Sample Survey Methodology. E- Library, a dedicated computer lab for the students of the college, is functioning to support the studies and maximize the use of e-resources and facilitate internet browsing for academic purpose. Reference Section cum conference room is open for the academic events to

take place. The ambience is very welcoming with comfortable sitting. Library is treasured with very valuable TALKING GITA Signature Edition which is available in 15 Languages. Two units of new OPAC are procured by the library. These are having latest features like touch screen to enable users to locate library resources easily. Patron Tracking System is used to register footfall of the library users.

Library Book Bank: We have a very rich book bank collection of 12665 books for needy students. This year we purchased 132 books of Rs. 63,552 under book bank section. Deserving and meritorious students are entitled for this facility. They avail this facility twice in a year. Library Services to Differently Abled User: The college library supports the differently abled users through numerous assistive devices and softwares like Braille s/w JAWS, ANGEL DAISY Reader, MP3 Recorder, Laptops, Zoom Ex Instant Text Reader, Lex Portable Camera, etc. for the teaching and learning. Access to Braille Library and Sound Recording Facility is also provided to visually impaired students. Five computer work stations are dedicated for this purpose. Library also subscribes to 'White Print', an English Braille magazine. Library Activities: Continuous orientation programs are conducted to guide students to use the library resources effectively. Four day Information Literacy workshop was conducted for 1st year students of the college on the topic INFORMATION LITERACY SKILLS FOR ACCESSING & UTILIZING LIBRARY RESOURCES. The students were made aware about the available library resources, open educational resources (OER), N LIST resources and DELNET resources, National Digital Library of India (NDLI), Sugamya Pustakalaya ONOS resources.



To motivate library users & inculcate reading habits and provide wider platform for book selection, college library organized BOOK FAIR on 06th March 2025. Leading publishers across all the disciplines were invited to display their collection. Overwhelming response was received from the faculty and the students of the college. College Library also imparts training to the students pursuing career in the field of Library Science. Students from IGNOU and SOL, University of Delhi were trained for a month in providing library services and routine operations.



Dr. Garima Gaur Srivastava (Librarian) was Awarded Phd in Library & Information Sc. on the topic Marketing of Library and Information Science Products and Services of the University Libraries in Delhi: A Study. She published an article "Fostering Sustainability through Innovative Social Media Marketing: Perspectives from University Libraries in Delhi" UGC CARE listed journal Library Herald. She was invited by the Delhi public library as the chief speaker at the conference on "मानवता सेवा और समता के प्रतीक एवं युवाओं के आदर्श तथा मार्गदर्शक स्वामी विवेकानन्द" on the occasion of Swami Vivekanand jayanti and National Youth Day. She was the Invited Speaker in Delhi Book Fair 2024, to share views on "Global Influence of Indian Books" She was also the Resource Person at SCERT for INSET Programme for the Librarians on the topics Digital Copyright Issues in Libraries, Use of AI power tools: Issues and Challenges.

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)

IQAC has collected the information and successfully submitted AQAR to NAAC for the year 2023-24 with support from all colleagues. This year IQAC has also initiated to collect the APAR forms for the year 2023-24 from all faculty members for the record and as a step towards academic audit. IQAC is proud of its role in ensuring qualitative initiatives and facilitation of projects undertaken by the faculty members, administration and departmental societies.

IQAC contributed to making the process of promotion of faculty members smooth and helped in achieving promotions of more than 60 colleagues at different academic levels, from level seven to the level of Professors.

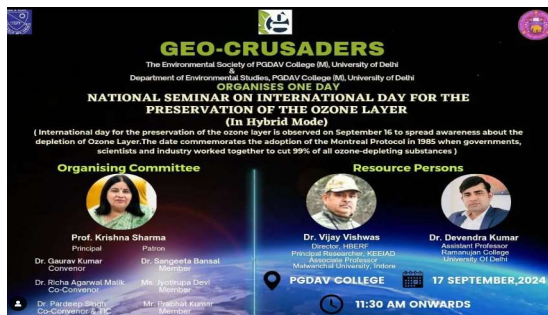

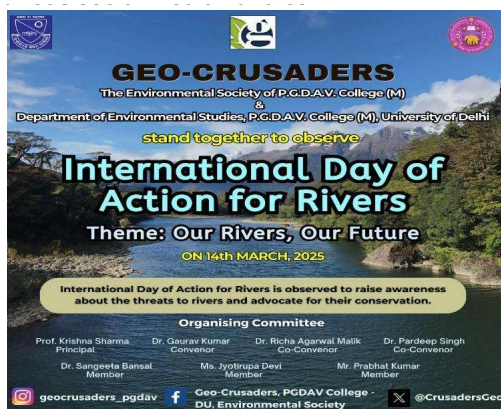

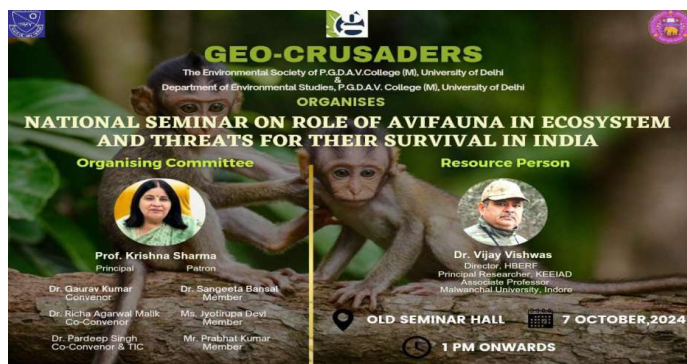
